The Wilderness is an analog-voiced delay with up to 1000 milliseconds of delay time. The intuitive user-interface includes mix, modulation, and feedback controls to customize the character of the delay. The Wilderness includes tap and ramp operation modes. Tap mode offers tap tempo functionality with four subdivisions. Ramp mode allows the user to set slow and fast delay times and accelerate between the two, creating a pitch-shifting effect.
